## **Getting Here**

There are two entrances to the office building: one on Robert-Bourassa and the other on Sherbrooke Street West.

Upon entering the building, locate the elevator and press "15" on the number pad to summon one of the three lifts that will take you up to the 15th floor. As you step out of the elevator, you'll find VIA's office entrance on your left.

Please be aware that VIA's office is usually locked outside regular work hours. If you plan to arrive early, kindly reach out to Angelica by texting or calling the number provided above so that she can assist you with access.





## **Parking**

If you require parking, you can access the garage of the building via Robert Bourassa. Please let us know so we can take care of your parking cost. You may also find street parking on Sherbrooke or any other street around the building if you prefer.

### **Public Transit**

- McGill is the closest metro station (Green Line) and there are bus stops on Robert Bourassa and Sherbrooke Street (bus 24).
- VIA is a 3-minute walk from the McGill metro station: exit the station onto Robert Bourassa and walk towards Sherbrooke St. We are right on that corner of Robert Bourassa and Sherbrooke.
